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## CHAPTER XV.—OWNERSHIP OF HOMES.

### INTRODUCTION.

The inquiry as to ownership of homes has been made at each of the last four censuses. The statistics here presented relate to continental United States as a whole, states, counties, and those incorporated places having 10,000 inhabitants or more. Statistics for Alaska, Hawaii, and Porto Rico are given in Vol. III of the Fourteenth Census Reports.

At the census of 1920, as in 1890, but not in 1900 or 1910, the inquiry as to encumbrance covered value of mortgaged homes, amount of mortgage indebtedness, and rate of interest paid. Statistics on these branches of the subject, however, are to be published separately in a special report, and the tables in this chapter relate solely to the facts of proprietorship and encumbrance. The term "proprietorship," as here used, is not restricted to ownership but has its full legal meaning and covers both ownership and tenancy.

At the censuses of 1920, 1910, and 1890 the returns on home ownership were tabulated with reference to "census families," which include certain groups that may be termed "economic families," such as occupants or inmates of hotels, boarding houses, or institutions. Thus the census family is not in all cases identical with the private family. At the census of 1900 the statistics for the total population of the United States and of each state were tabulated with reference to both census families and private families, but the statistics for cities and those as to color or race were tabulated only with reference to private families. Accordingly the figures for 1900 given in Tables 3, 5, 6, and 7 are not exactly comparable with those for 1910 and 1920.

For census purposes a home is treated as owned if it is owned wholly or in part by the head of the family

living in it, or by his wife, or by a son or a daughter, or by any other relative living in the same house with the head of the family. (But if the home is owned by a lodger or boarder who is not related to the head of the family occupying it, it is treated as a rented home.) Every home not owned, either wholly or in part, by the family living in it is classed as rented, whether rent is actually paid or not.

In the case of an apartment house or other plural-family dwelling, the portion occupied by each family is treated as a separate home and is returned as rented, owned free, or owned encumbered, as the case may be.

**Apportionment of "unknown."**—For a small proportion of the homes (2.2 per cent in 1920) no returns were made as to proprietorship; and for a small proportion of those returned as owned (2.6 per cent in 1920) information as to encumbrance was lacking. In tabulating the census of 1890 these unknown items were distributed in the same proportions as the known items; and in Table 1, in which figures for 1890 are shown, the statistics for the other census years have been distributed in the same manner, in order to make them comparable with those for 1890. In computing the percentages in Tables 4, 5, and 7 the unknown items have also been distributed. The method employed was as follows:

The "Tenure Unknown" for each state were distributed between "Rented" and "Owned" in the proportions of the known figures for rented and owned homes. The number thus allotted as owned was then added to the number returned as owned but unknown as to encumbrance, and the sum of these two unknown items was distributed between the "Free" and "Encumbered" groups on the basis of the proportions which these two groups formed of the total number of owned homes for which returns as to encumbrance were made.


