Judge Clayton has begun to rhetorize again in Congress, after having taken the field in Georgia as a trumpeter of nullification. We do not know whether he understands Latin. but there is a sentence of Cicero of which the import is well worth study and reflection on the part of all noisy and empty declaimers. Nihil tam furiosum est quam verborum, vel optimorum, inanis sonitus, nulla subjectu scientia aut sententia.
