

ELECTION FOR CONGRESS. Objections as strong, if not stronger, exist against Judge Clayton, as those which existed against the late Governor Gilmer. The Ex Governor was desirous of depriving the people of the Gold Mines, and throwing their avails into the Treasury.— Judge Clayton decides, that a law of the last session is unconstitutional, and that the Indians have the right to dig for gold. In fact the Judge's opinion goes completely to deprive the State of *all* the benefit of the Gold Mines. Can the people of Georgia *think* of sending a man to Congress who maintains such a doctrine—a doctrine, which Gov. Gilmer himself thinks, will form an almost insuperable barrier to the removal of the Cherokees. We will not yet believe it.
