

*Treaty with the Cherokees.*—The 18th ult. was the day appointed by the commissioners for the convening of the Cherokees at the Agency, for the purpose of holding the treaty contemplated by the act of Congress under which they act. The Indians did not assemble, and the commissioners, after waiting upon them a few days, adjourned without success. We understand that the commissioners, after they left the Agency, received a communication from some leading Cherokees, which induced them to return thither, but what the purport of that communication was, we do not know.—*Hivassan.*
