

Cherokee Lands of North Carolina.—On the 21st ult. Gov. Iredell transmitted to the Legislature the Report of Gen. R. M. Saunders, who acted as a Commissioner in contracting for the purchase of certain reservations of land claimed by the Cherokee Indians. It appears from the Report, that 13 reservations of one class, were contracted for at \$4,930; and 13 other reservations, at \$9,940—in all, for 26 reservations, 14,770. The number of acres contracted for, is not ascertained. The land is represented as valuable; and the contracts will probably be ratified by the Legislature.
