

Mr. *Clayton* of Clark, from the joint committee appointed to wait on his Excellency JOHN FORSYTH, and to inform him of his election as Governor, reported that they had performed the duty assigned them, and received for answer, that he accepts the appointment, and that he will attend in the Representative Chamber this day at half past 12 o'clock, for the purpose of taking the oath of office, agreeably to the provisions of the Constitution.

At the appointed hour, the President and members of Senate proceeded to the Representative Chamber. and being seated, the committee of arrangements conducted his Excellency John Forsyth, to a seat prepared between the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, attended by Judicial officers, members of Congress, State-house officers, &c. when his excellency addressed the General Assembly, and took the oath prescribed by the Constitution.
