Mr. Baber from the joint committee on Agriculture and Internal Improvement, to whom was referred the documents relating to the improvement of the navigation of the Ocmulgee river from Macon to its junction with the Oconee river, made a report, which was read and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Powell, the Senate resolved itself into a committee of the whole on the bill for the division of the late acquired counties. The bill was reported without amendment. The Senate took up and agreed to the report, when the bill was read the third time and passed.

The bill to lay out and form a new county out of the counties of DeKalb, Fayette, Coweta, and Carrol, was taken up and negatived by the casting vote of the acting President (Mr. Clayton of Clark.)
