

The two Missionaries, with four other persons, who were lately arrested by a military force acting under the authority of the State of Georgia in the Cherokee Nation, were brought up before Judge Clayton, at March term of the Superior Court of Gwinnet county, on a writ of *Habeas Corpus*. Their case was argued at length, by Dougherty and Trippe, for the State, and Harris, Hardin and Underwood, for the defendants. The decision of the Judge was as follows—“Let the two Missionaries (one of them being a Post Master) be discharged, and let the other four persons be bound over to answer to the misdemeanor charged against them, they having exhibited no excuse.”
