

*Interesting Decision* — We insert in our subsequent columns an interesting decision of Judge Clayton, which gives to the clause of the Constitution of the State of Georgia, under which the Governor acted in declaring the office of Secretary of State vacant, a directly contrary construction to that of his Excellency.
